Students take core courses as a cohort then specialize in one of three tracks: international education; leadership & administration; or student affairs.

Students have the opportunity to travel to Washington D.C. (fall) and Richmond, VA (spring) to meet with policymakers and higher education association leaders.

Students can travel abroad on a different 10-day study abroad experience each year.

Our signature 1 program, 3 track approach lets students build a personalized plan of study based on their academic and professional goals with tracks in:
